The petitioner appears to be an accused in six different criminal complaints, out of which two cases have been resulted in acquittal, one case has been resulted in conviction, in other two cases, investigation is going on and the last case is pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate-II, Thanjavur in C.C.No.1 of 2021, for the offences under Sections 279, 304A and 337 of IPC.
