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ORDER

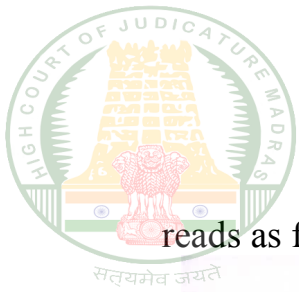
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The petitioner has filed this petition to quash the charge sheet in S.C.No. 38 of 2024 for the offences punishable under Section 294(b) and 307 of IPC pending before the Sub Court, Ramanathapuram District as against the petitioners.

2. The allegation in the Charge Sheet is that due to prior enmity, the petitioners had attacked the defacto complainant with knife and abused him in filthy language.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the allegation in the Charge Sheet would not constitute the offence under Section 307 of IPC; He would further submit that even the Doctor, who treated the defacto complainant has certified that the defacto complainant sustained only a simple injury in his hands.

4. Admittedly, the petitioners and the second respondent are known to each other and they have now entered into a compromise and decided to give a quietus to the entire dispute. The parties have filed a joint compromise memo dated 11th September 2025 and the scanned copy of the compromise memo



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reads as follows:

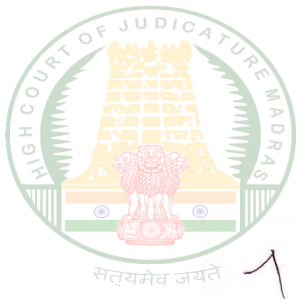

We both the parties are hereby agreed to settle the matter as follows.

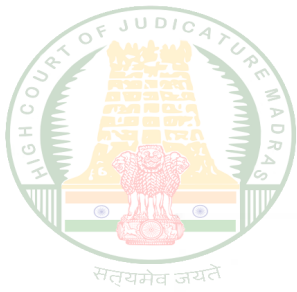

The charge sheet was filed in CC.No.38/2024 on the file of the Judicial Sub Court, Ramanathapuram, Ramanathapuram District.

2.It is submit that the prosecution is that, the defacto complainant and Accused No.1 were working in Same company in Malaysia. Due to the previous dispute in their job related, on 28.01.2017 at about 6 pm, The accused had chased the defacto complainant's bike in the place Regunathaptram Kundoorani Bus stop and assaulted the defacto complainant with one sword on the defacto complainant's right hand Elbow. Then on the screaming from one defcto complainant/victim, the defacto complainant's brother came to occurrence place. Then the accused fled from the scene of the occurrence. Hence the complaint was registered as against the petitioners. The same was registered in Crime.NO.10/2017 under section 294(b) and 307 of IPC dated 28.01.2017.

3. It is submit that I have agreed to withdraw the complaint in CC.No.38/2024 pending before the Sub Court, Ramanathapuram,

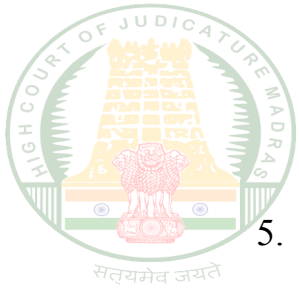

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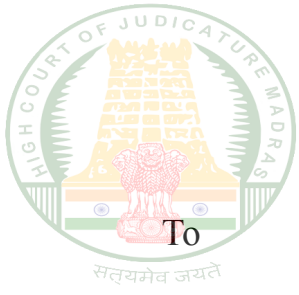

In view of the fact that the allegation made in the Charge Sheet would, at best, attract the offence under Section 324 of IPC and considering the nature of the offences and the relationship between the parties, this Court is of the view that no useful purpose would be served by keeping the impugned final report pending trial. Accordingly, the impugned Charge Sheet in S.C.No.38 of 2024 pending before the Sub Court, Ramanathapuram District, is quashed and the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.
