Since no adverse orders are proposed to be passed against the respondent, this Writ Petition is disposed of at the time of admission by directing the respondent to consider the applications/representations of the petitioner and dispose of the same on merits and in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
