PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS, 2023

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.124 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/ A1 to A4, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable (*) under Sections 296(b), 118(1), 351(2) of BNS and Section 4 of TNPWH Act, in Crime No.124 of 2025, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 26.04.2025, the defacto complainant and the accused persons came to the respondent Police station for enquiry, at that time, the accused persons picked up quarrel with the defacto complainant and abused her in filthy language and also attacked her with stones and caused injury.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that the petitioners



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are innocent persons and they have not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. Hence, he prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

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4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor submits that the injured has been discharged from the hospital and it is a case and counter case.

5. Considering the nature of allegations and also considering the fact that the injured has been discharged from the hospital and it is a case and counter case, this court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Paramakudi, Ramanathapuram District, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each, with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed and on further condition that:

[a] the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.



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[b] the petitioners shall report before the respondent Police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders.

[c] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS 2023.
