ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 4(1)(C) and 4(1)(A) TN Prohibition (Amendment) Act, in Crime No.129 of 2025, seeks anticipatory bail.

When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submits that the petitioner is a habitual offender and already he involved in two similar cases in Crime Nos.179 and 59 of 2024. Hence, he strongly opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner and prayed to dismiss this petition.
