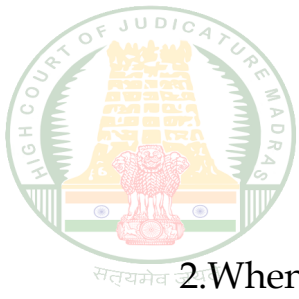
PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 39 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/ Accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 4(1)(C) and 4(1)(A) TN Prohibition (Amendment) Act, 2024 in Crime No.39 of 2025, seeks anticipatory bail.



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2. When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submits that the petitioner is a habitual offender and already he involved in nine cases. Hence, he strongly opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner and prayed to dismiss this petition.

3. Considering the antecedent of the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Hence this criminal original petition is dismissed.
