ORDER

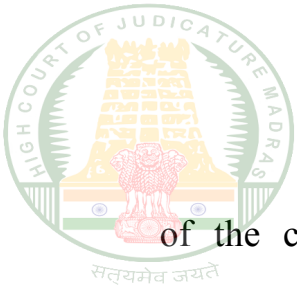
(Order of the Court was made by S.SRIMATHY,J.)
