ORDER

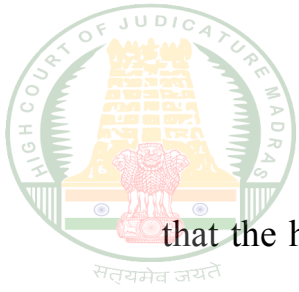
(Order of the Court was made by S.SRIMATHY,J.)

The writ petitioner is the wife of the convict and for attending serious illness of her father-in-law, she has sought for twenty one(21) days emergency leave to the convict through her representation dated 13.05.2025.

2.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents, on instructions, states that the representation of the petitioner has been considered in accordance with law and five(5) days emergency leave with escort may be granted to the convict to attend the serious illness of his father. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor further states that the detainee may inform the prison authority about the convenient period for which he wants five days emergency leave for the purpose of attending serious illness of his father.

3.Considering the submission made by the learned Additional Public Prosecutor and the purpose for which the leave sought, this Court is of the opinion

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that the husband of the petitioner shall be granted emergency leave for five days with escort to attend serious illness of his father.

4. With the above observation and direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
