PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No.185/2025 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-



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The petitioner/ Accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 22.05.2025 for the offences under section 310(2) of BNS, 2023 @ 191(2), 191(3), 296(b), 118(1), 109, 309(6) and 351(3) of BNS, 2023 in Crime No.185 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner herein and other accused trespassed into the boys hostel and threatened the defacto complainant and others and locked them in a room and attacked him with the backside of the knife and took 13 Mobile phones, ATM card, Silver chain and a sum of Rs.2,300/- from them and caused injuries. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He further submits that based on the confession of co-accused only the petitioner herein is arrayed as accused. Hence, he seeks bail.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) appearing for the respondent – Police submitted that the property has been recovered and that there is no previous case pending against the petitioner. He further submitted that investigation of the case is pending and hence, he strongly, opposed to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and also



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the fact that property has been recovered and that there is no previous case pending against the petitioner and also taking into consideration the period of incarceration and taking note of the fact that the petitioner is going to join in the college, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) along with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.III, Trichy and on further conditions that :-

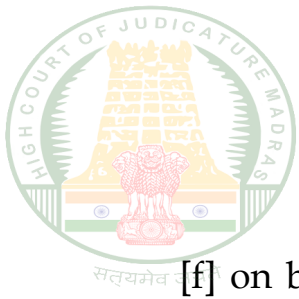
[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am and 5.00 pm., until further orders;

[c] the petitioner shall submit his residential address and contact number to the learned Judicial Magistrate No.III, Trichy. If he changes the residence, he shall inform the same to the concerned Magistrate without fail.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[e] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;



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[f] on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]; and

[g] if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS, 2023.
