PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :- For Bail in Crime No.174 of 2025 on the file of the Respondent Police.



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ORDER: This Court made the following order :-

The petitioner / Accused No.7, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 29.04.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 140(3), 191(1) of BNS 127(2), 131, 140(1), 191(2), 191(3), 308(5), 351(3), 61(2) of BNS in Crime No.174 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that there was previous enmity between one Senthil and other accused persons with regard to the sharing of commission from the real-estate business, due to which, the petitioner and other accused persons abducted him and kept him in illegal custody for two days. Based on the complaint given by the wife of the said Senthil, the victim was secured and the accused persons were arrested. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. The petitioner is ready and willing to abide any conditions that may be imposed by this Court. He would further submit that the petitioner is in custody from 29.04.2025 nearly 41 days. Hence, he seeks bail.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) would submit that due to sharing of commission from the real-estate business, there was dispute the one



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Senthil and other accused persons. Due to which, the accused persons abducted him and detained in illegal custody. Totally there are 13 accused, this petitioner was arrayed as Accused No.7. The other Accused Nos.5,6,8,9,10,11,12 & 13 were granted bail by this Court. This petitioner is having five previous cases. Hence, he objected to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also taking note of the fact that in this case, the other Accused Nos.5,6,8,9,10,11,12 & 13 were granted bail, the petitioner/accused No.7 was remanded into judicial custody on 29.04.2025, taking into consideration of the period of incarceration, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate No.2, Kumbakonam and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] The petitioner shall furnish his residential address and mobile number to



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the Judicial Magistrate No.2, Kumbakonam. If the petitioner changes his residential
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address, he shall report the same to the Judicial Magistrate No.2, Kumbakonam;

[c] the petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent police daily at 10.30a.m., for the period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required;

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
