ORDER

The petitioner has filed this application seeking a direction to the respondents 1 to 4 to take action as against the fifth respondent, based on the petitioner's representation dated 01.06.2025.

2.The petitioner claims that he has purchased a Mahendra Thar vehicle bearing Registration No.TN 05 CJ 4434 from the fifth respondent and the fifth respondent has also handed over the car. However, he has not handed over the RC book and other records. In the meantime, one

Gowthaman has lodged a complaint that his car has been taken away by the fifth respondent, for which, the respondent police has conducted a petition enquiry in CSR No.226 of 2025, ascertained that the documents are in the name of one Prashanth and have handed over the vehicle to the person who is in possession of the RC book for the vehicle bearing Registration No.TN 05 CJ 4434.

3.The case of the petitioner is that the fifth respondent by receiving money handed over the car, but not transferred RC book.

4.This Court is not inclined to entertain this petition. Accordingly, this writ petition stands dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to work out his remedy before before the civil Court.
