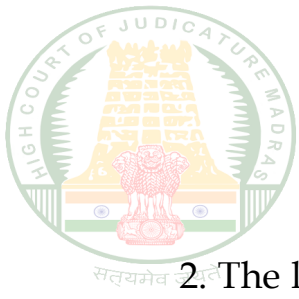

This petition is filed to modify the condition which was imposed on the petitioners in Crl.A(MD)Nos.360 and 346 of 2025 dated 09.04.2025



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2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submitted that the petitioners have been complying with the condition regularly, without any default.

3. Considering the fact that the petitioners are complying the condition regularly and also in view of the reasons cited by the petitioners in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, I feel that the condition imposed on the petitioner can be modified.

4. Accordingly, the condition No.32(iii) already imposed on the petitioners in Crl.A(MD)Nos.360 and 346 of 2025, dated 09.04.2025, is hereby modified as follows:

" The petitioner shall report before the Inspector of Police, Melur Police Station, Melur, Madurai, twice in a month (i.e., on the 1st and 15th of every English Calender month) at 10.30 a.m., till the disposal of the appeal. If 1st and 15 day falls on a holiday, the petitioner shall appear before the above said Court on the next working day."

5. Other conditions shall hold good.
