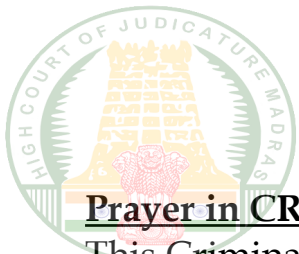

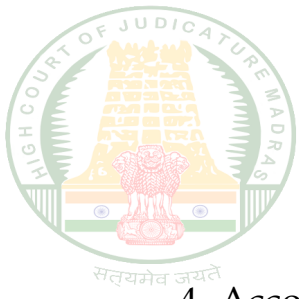

ORDER

This petition is filed to relax the condition which was imposed on the petitioners in Crl.A.(MD)No.637 of 2025, dated 09.06.2025 by this Court.

2. When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the State, on instructions, would submit that the petitioners have been complying the condition regularly, without any default.

3. Considering the fact that the petitioners are complying the condition regularly and also taking into consideration of the reasons cited by the petitioners in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, I feel that the condition imposed on the petitioners can be modified to a certain extent.



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4. Accordingly, the condition already imposed is modified and the petitioners shall appear and sign before the respondent-police, twice in a month i.e., on 1st and 15th day of every English calendar month, till the disposal of the appeal.
