2. When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents would submit that the representation of the petitioner, dated 06.06.2025 will be



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considered and suitable orders will be passed within a week.

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3. Recording the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, without going into the merits of the matter, we direct the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner, dated 06.06.2025 and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

4. Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
