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ORDER

Both the parties are appeared before this Court and a compromise memo, dated 25.04.2025 has also been filed before this Court. The revision petitioner has settled the permanent alimony to a tune of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs only), out of which an amount of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs only) has already been paid in cash. The remaining amount of Rs.3,00,000/- is deposited to the credit of M.C.No.34 of 2011 on the file of Family Court, Madurai.

2. The respondent wife is permitted to withdraw the said amount by filing appropriate petition before the learned Trial Court. The learned Trial Court is directed to appreciate the petition to be filed by the wife forthwith. The compromise memo, dated 25.04.2025 shall form part and parcel of the order and the same is extracted hereunder:



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JOINT COMPROMISE MEMO

1. It is respectfully submitted that the Petitioner had filed this Criminal Revision Petition Challenging the Order dated 26.12.2019 in MC.No.34 of 2011 on the file of Learned Family Court, Madurai.

2. It is submitted that the petitioner is the husband and the respondent is the wife and due to some misunderstanding and strained in the relationship between the both parties leading to the irretrievable broke down. Now the matter has been compromised and settled amicably at the intervention of their relatives, well wishers and elders of the village.

3. It is submitted that Now the both parties want to quit the entire proceedings initiated against each other and in furtherance to the compromise the petitioner moved the divorce application in H.M.O.P.No. of 2024 before Learned Family Court, Madurai in which the petitioner agreed to give a sum of Rs.10,00,000/- as onetime alimony and the respondent also agreed same and agreed not to claim further and accepted to give consent for Divorce.

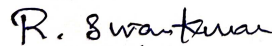
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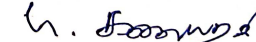
