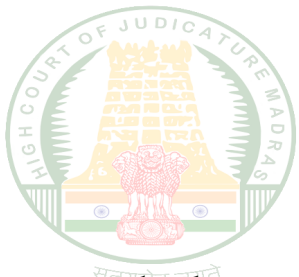

Criminal Miscellaneous Petition is filed Under Section 528 of BNSS praying, to relax the condition imposed in Crl.M.P.(MD). No. 864 of 2025 in Crl.A.(MD). No. 987 of 2024 dt. 23.01.2025.

Prayer in CRL A(MD). 987 of 2024 :

Criminal Appeal filed under Section 14 A (2) of SC/ST Prevention of Atrocities Amendment Act, to call for the records relating to the impugned order passed in Crl.M.P.No.5766 of 2024 dated 29.10.2024, on the file of the learned I Additional District and Sessions Judge (PCR), Trichy District and set aside the same as illegal

3. Considering the fact that the petitioner is complying the condition regularly and also in view of the reasons cited by the petitioner in the affidavit filed in support of this petition, I feel that the condition imposed on the petitioner can be relaxed.

Accordingly, the condition No.4 already imposed on the petitioner in CrI.M.P.(MD)No.864 of 2025 in CrI.A.(MD)No.987 of 2024 dated 23.01.2025 is hereby relaxed. The petitioner is directed to appear before the learned Principal District Judge, Chennai on all hearings and as and when required."

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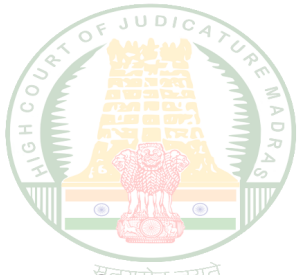
