**ORDER:** This Court made the following order :-

The petitioner / Accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 30.05.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 4(1)(A) of the TamilNadu Prohibition (Amendment) Act in Crime No.122 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that at the time of routine surveillance the respondent police found that the petitioner was in illegal possession of 4 TASMAL liquor bottles and cash Rs.800/- which is said to be sale proceeds of the liquor. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. The petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner is ready and willing to abide and conditions that may be imposed by this Court. He would further submit that the petitioner is in custody from 30.05.2025 nearly 17 days. Hence, he seeks bail.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) would submit that the petitioner was found in possession of 4 TASMAL liquor bottles and cash Rs.800/- which is said to be sale proceeds of the liquor. The liquor bottles and cash Rs.800/- were recovered from the petitioner. This petitioner is having 11 previous cases, all are similar in nature. Hence, he strongly objected to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also taking note of the fact that in this case, the entire property was recovered from the petitioner, the petitioner/accused remanded into judicial custody on 30.05.2025, taking into consideration of the period of incarceration, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of Judicial Magistrate, Theni District and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] The petitioner shall furnish his residential address and contact number to the Judicial Magistrate, Theni District. If the petitioner changes his residential address, he shall report the same to the Judicial Magistrate, Theni District;

[c] the petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent police daily twice at 10.30 a.m. and 05.30p.m., until further orders.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].
