PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER : For Bail in Crime No.12 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/ Accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody



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on 29.04.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 498(A), 323, 354, 506(1) of IPC, 1860 and 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002 r/w 9 (m) & 10 POCSO Act 2012, in Crime No.12 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail,

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner is the husband of the defacto complainant, he physically and verbally abused her in filthy language. Furthermore, the petitioner sexually abused his own two daughters aged about 13 years and 11 years. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 29.04.2025. Hence, he seeks bail.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) submitted that the petitioner had sexually harassed his own daughters aged about 13 years and 11 years.. He further submitted that the investigation has been completed and the charge sheet has also been filed. However, he objected to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact that the investigation has been completed and the charge sheet has also been filed. Further, considering the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this court is



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inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

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6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Mahila Court, Karur, and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

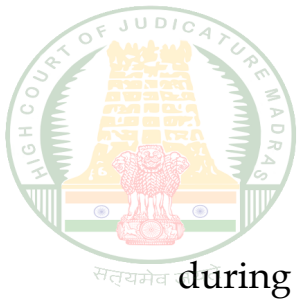
[b] The petitioner shall furnish his residential address and mobile number to the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Mahila Court, Karur.

(c) If the petitioner changes his residential address, he shall report the same to the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Mahila Court, Karur,

[d] the petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. and 05.30 p.m., until further orders.

[e] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[f] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either



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during investigation or trial.

[g] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[h] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
