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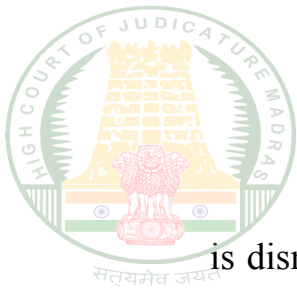
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ORDER

The petitioner has filed this petition to quash the FIR in Crime No. 102 of 2025 registered against him, on the file of the first respondent Police, for the offences under Sections 329(4), 296(b), 332(c), 64, 62 and 351(3) of BNS 2023 and Section 4 of the Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002.

2. When this petition is taken up for hearing, Mr.P.Kottaichamy, learned Government Advocate (CrI. Side), takes notice for the respondent Police and submits that the investigation in Crime No.102 of 2025 was completed and the final report has also been filed before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Kovilpatti, through e-filing on 18.04.2025.

3. Since it is reported that the final report has been filed in Crime No.102 of 2025, without ascertaining the materials relied on by the investigating agency in the final report, this Court is not inclined to proceed with the available FIR. Therefore, this Criminal Original Petition



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is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the final report, if he is having any ground. Mere filing of the final report through e-filing is not sufficient. The respondent Police shall ensure that the final report is taken on file within a reasonable time. It is not only the responsibility of the respondent Police, the trial Court is also expected to take the final report on file, without any delay.
