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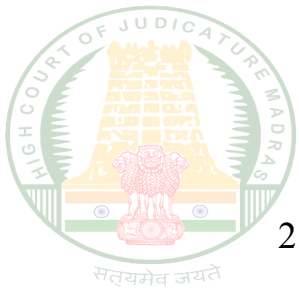

Recording the submission of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor, the writ petition is disposed of directing the respondent to consider the representation made by the petitioner dated 10.06.2025 and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of one week from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
