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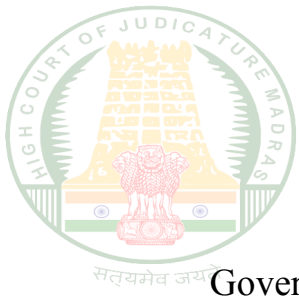

ORDER

The petitioner herein seeks a direction to the fourth respondent to survey the property belonged to him situated in Survey No.636/10B, Thottanampatti Village, Vendasandur Taluk, Dindigul District, by considering his representation dated 04.05.2025.

2.Heard the arguments of Mr.A.Mohamed Riyaz, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, Mrs.K.Malathi, learned Additional



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Government Pleader appearing for the respondents 1 to 4 and Mr.M.Vaikkam Karunanithi, learned Government Advocate appearing for the fifth respondent. By consent of both sides, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3.According to the petitioner, the above mentioned property is his ancestral property and the patta for the said property stands in the name of the petitioner's deceased father, Mohamed Ibrahim, in Patta No.1497. The legal heirship certificate produced by the petitioner would indicate that the petitioner's father died on 17.01.2021, leaving behind the petitioner as only surviving legal heir. The petitioner submitted an online application before the respondents on 21.01.2025 in Application No. 2025/0123/13/009103, seeking survey of the subject property. The same has not been considered. Hence, the petitioner has come before this Court.

4.The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents 1 to 4 would submit the application of the petitioner will be considered on its own merits within the time stipulated by this Court.



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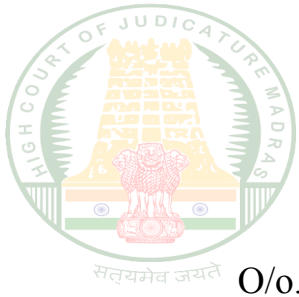
