Heard Mr.S.M.Arun Kumar, learned counsel for the Petitioner, Mr.M.Balakrishnan, learned Counsel for the Respondent Nos.1 to 5 and Mr.M.Karunanithi, learned Government Advocate for the Respondent No.7.

The learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition has been filed under Section 5 of the Limitation Act, 1963, seeking to condone the delay of 276 days in filing the criminal revision petition against the order passed in Crl.M.P.No.1 of 2024 , dated 13.06.2024 by the Judicial Magistrate, Melur.
