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ORDER

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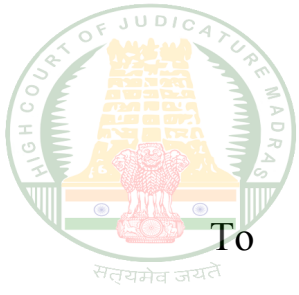
The petitioner has approached this court with a grievance that the respondent police have not conducted investigation on her complaint.
