ORDER

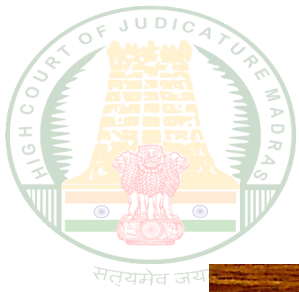
This Criminal Revision Case has been filed challenging the order in M.C.No.72 of 2023 dated 05.03.2025 passed by the Family Court, Tirunelveli.



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2. The matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre attached to this Court and the settlement agreement has been arrived between the parties and it is agreed that the petitioner would continue to pay a monthly maintenance of Rs.25,000/- regularly as fixed by the learned Family Court, Tirunelveli in M.C.No.72 of 2023. Pointing out that the husband is receiving take home salary of Rs.80,000/- per month, the learned counsel for the petitioner/ husband sought permission to pay the arrears amount in 3 installments. Accordingly, directing the husband to pay the arrears of amount in three instalments by 20th of every month from September, 2025 to November, 2025, this criminal revision case is disposed of. The settlement agreement, dated 05.08.2025 shall form part and parcel of the order and the same is extracted hereunder:

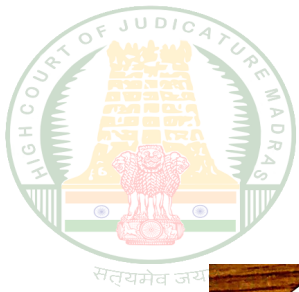
WHEREAS

1. Disputes and difference had arisen between the parties hereto and Crl.R.C.761 of 2025 was filed on 19.06.2025 before the Madurai Bench of Madras High Court.
2. The matter was referred to mediation/conciliation vide an order dated 24.07.2025 / passed by Hon'ble Ms.Justice.L.Victoria Gowri
3. The parties agreed that K.Manavalan & S.Louis would act as their Mediator/Conciliator.
4. Two meetings were held during the process of Mediation/Conciliation from 31.07.2025 to 05.08.2025 and the parties have with the assistance of the Mediator/Conciliator voluntarily arrived at an amicable solution resolving the above mentioned disputes and difference.
5. The parties hereto confirm and declare that they have voluntarily and of their own free will arrived at this Settlement Agreement in the presence of the Mediator/Conciliator.

A. The Petitioner herein agreed to pay the monthly maintenance of Rs.25,000 per month regularly as fixed by the in M.C.No.72 of 2023 on the file of family court Tirunelveli.

B. The Petitioner submit that he failed to pay 6 months of maintenance amount, further he agreed to pay the arrears amount within two months in two installments.

7. By signing this Agreement the Parties hereto state that they have no further claims or demands against each other with respect to Crl.R.C.761 of 2025 and all disputes and difference in this regard have been amicably settled by the parties hereto through the process of conciliation/Mediation.
