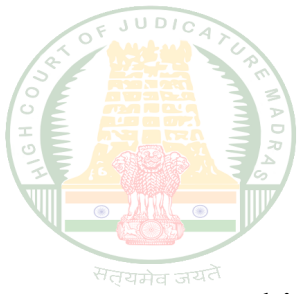

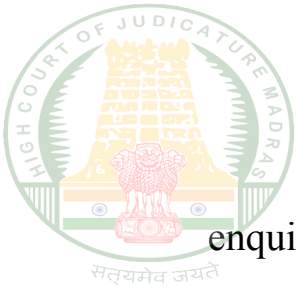

ORDER

The petitioner has lodged a complaint against the 3rd and 4th respondent / police officials that they have detained the petitioner's vehicle when he appeared before them for an enquiry and has approached this Court for a direction to take action on his complaint.

2.When this petition is taken up for hearing, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police submits the petitioner was summoned for enquiry in CSR No.205 of 2025 on 22.03.2025 and on that day the petitioner had attended the



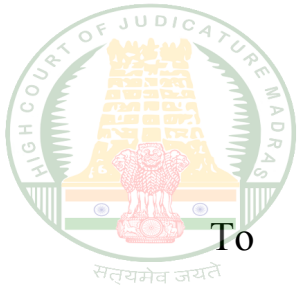
