PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :- For Bail in Crime No.38 of 2025 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER: This Court made the following order :-

The petitioner / Accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody



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on 12.06.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 4(1)(A), 4(1)(C), 4(1-A) (2) of TamilNadu Prohibition (Amendment) Act, 2024 in Crime No.38 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the respondent police found that the petitioner was in illegal possession of 5 liters of Country Arrack in plastic can for sale. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. The petitioner is ready and willing to abide and conditions that may be imposed by this Court. He would further submit that the petitioner is in custody from 12.06.2025 nearly 13 days. Hence, he seeks bail.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) would submit that the respondent found that the petitioner was in illegal possession of 5 liters of country Arrack for sale. The entire properties have been recovered from the petitioner. There is no previous case against this petitioner. However, he strongly objected to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also taking note of the fact that in this case, the entire properties were seized by the respondent police, there is no previous case against the petitioner, the



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petitioner/accused remanded into judicial custody on 12.06.2025, taking into
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consideration of the period of incarceration, this court is inclined to grant bail to the
petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a
bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each
for a like sum to the satisfaction of District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate,
Peravurani and on further conditions that :-

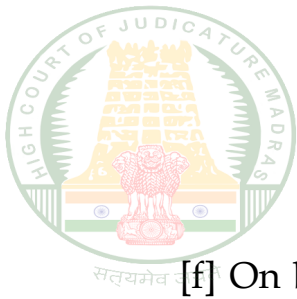
[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the
surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass
Book to ensure their identity.

[b] The petitioner shall furnish his residential address and contact number to
the District Munsif cum Judicial Magistrate, Peravurani. If the petitioner changes his
residential address, he shall report the same to the District Munsif cum Judicial
Magistrate, Peravurani;

[c] the petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent police daily
twice at 10.30 a.m., and 05.30p.m., until further orders.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during
investigation or trial.



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[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
