PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :- C-24AB. For Anticipatory Bail in Crime
No.156 of 2025 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioners, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 318(4) of BNS, in Crime No. 156 of 2025, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner has cheated the defacto complainant to the tune of Rs.5,05,000/- for getting free house cite patta in favour of him. But the petitioners did not keep their promise. Hence the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. He further submitted that the petitioners are ready and willing to abide by any conditions which may be imposed by this Court. Hence, he seeks anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

5. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) submitted that the petitioners have no previous cases and investigation is yet to be completed. However, he opposed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, and the nature of offence, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners subject to certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, on condition that each of the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each, for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Karur, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and on further conditions that:

[a] the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left

thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity;

[b] the first petitioner/A1 is directed to deposit a sum of Rs. 1,00,000/- (Rupee one lakh only) to the credit of the Crime No.156 of 2025; and the second petitioner/A2 is directed to deposit a sum of Rs.75,000/- (Rupees Seventy five thousand only) to the credit of Crime No.156 of 2025. On such deposit being made, the learned Magistrate shall accept the sureties furnished by the petitioners;

[c] the petitioners shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m., until further orders;

[d]the petitioners shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[d]the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[e]On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions

have been imposed and the petitioners are released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560];

[f]If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS.
