2. The petitioner appears to be a Vice-President of the Board of Trustees of the trust, namely, Shri.Bhagawathi Amman Trust, located in Kulithalai.

3. It is specific case of the petitioner that the rents from the shops are not been collected and there a dispute between the President and Secretary and a suit in O.S.No.9 of 2019 is also pending before the Kulithalai Court. Hence, the petitioner has given a representation to the Official respondents 3 and 4 to consider the collection of the rent.

4. The learned Additional Government Pleader for the respondents 3 and 4 submits that the petitioner's representation will be considered and disposed of on merits, after hearing the Secretary and the President of the Trust, who are, incidentally, litigating each other in O.S.No.9 of 2019.
