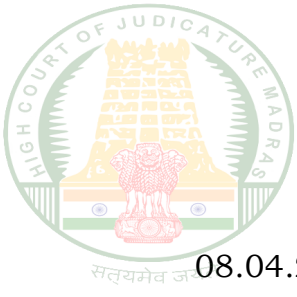
**PRAYER:** Criminal Revision Petition is filed under Section 438 r/w 442 of BNSS, to set aside the order passed in M.C.No.99 of 2017 dated 26.04.2023 on the file of the learned Family Court, Madurai, by allowing this criminal revision petition in so far as rejecting maintenance to the 1<sup>st</sup> petitioner.

**ORDER**

In terms of the order passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Special Leave to Appeal (C) Nos.10061 to 10064 of 2025, dated



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08.04.2025, the parties have entered into a compromise and the husband had paid an amount of Rs.30,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Lakhs only) to the credit of the wife as one time settlement and the same has been entered into a settlement.

2. The settlement agreement has been arrived before the Mediation Center attached to this Court and the same is placed before me. The scanned copy of the settlement agreement is extracted as follows:



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**SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

This settlement agreement entered into on 03.07.2024 between

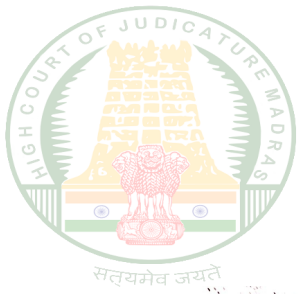

Whereas

1. Disputes and differences had arisen between the parties hereto and SLP(Civil)No.41516/2022 was filed on 30.11.2022 before the Honourable Supreme Court of India.
2. The matter was referred to mediation/conciliation vide an order dated 22.03.2024 passed by Honourable **Ms.Justice Aniruddha Bose & The Honourable Mr.Justice.Sanjay Kumar**
3. The parties agree that **J.Alaguram Jothi** would act as their Mediator/Conciliator.
4. Several meetings were held during the process of Mediation/Conciliation from 22.04.2024 to 03.07.2024 and the parties have with the assistance of the Mediator/Conciliator voluntarily arrived at an amicable solution resolving the above mentioned disputes and differences.
5. The parties hereto confirm and declare that they have voluntarily and of their own free will arrived at this settlement agreement in the presence of the Mediator/Conciliator.



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6. The following settlement has been arrived at between the parties hereto

A. The SLP is filed against the Rev.Appl.(MD)No.s 133 & 134 of 2021 against the impugned final common judgment and order at 23.10.2019 passed by Madurai Bench of Madras High Court in CMA(MD)No.555 & 556 of 2015 confirming the order dismissing the claim for divorce by the husband and confirming the order allowing the petition for restitution of conjugal rights.

B. Now after negotiation the parties have arrived at the following settlement between them.

a. That on the husband /petitioner agreed for paying one time settlement of a sum of Rs.30,00,000/- (Rupees thirty lakhs only) towards permanent maintenance for the wife/respondent and her minor child namely Ms.Vinusha.

Accordingly, the petitioner has brought demand drafts drawn in the name of the respondent Mrs.S.Deepa as detailed below:

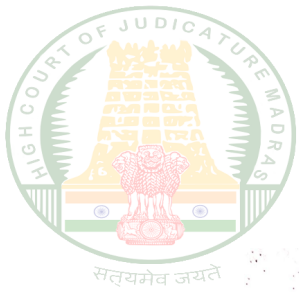

- b. That on receipt of such amount as full and final settlement towards permanent maintenance for herself and on behalf of minor child Ms.Vinusha, the respondent/wife agrees to grant divorce in favour of petitioner/husband. Both of them agreed that they shall jointly file an application for mutual consent before family court, Madurai and get proper order of Divorce.
- c. The petitioner/husband agrees that the custody of minor child Ms.Vinusha shall continue be with respondent/wife and the mother of the minor child. He agrees to withdraw the GWOP.No.1319/2023 on the file of the Family Court, Madurai.
- d. The respondent /wife agreed to give up all her claim for maintenance as ordered in MC.No.99/2017 dated 09.06.2023 on the file of the family court Madurai. Against the said order granting maintenance to the minor daughter the petitioner/husband filed an revision in Crl.R.C.(MD) No.588/2023 on the file of the Honourable Madurai Bench of Madras High Court. Against the order of dismissal of claim for maintenance





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by the wife, she has also filed a revision petition in Crl.R.C.(MD)No.709/2023 on the file of the Honourable Madurai Bench of Madras High Court. Both of them have now agreed to withdraw the respective revision petitions filed by them.

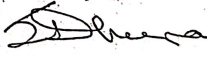
- e. The petitioner/husband has today handed over all the house-hold articles available at the matrimonial house to the respondent/wife and she has also received the same.
- f. Both of them agreed that they are giving up all the claims made against each other towards gold ornaments and silver articles.

7. By signing this agreement the parties hereto state that they have no further claims or demands against each other with respect to SLP (Civil)No. 41516 of 2023 and disputes and differences in this regard have been amicably settled by the parties hereto through the process of conciliation/Mediation.
