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COMMON ORDER

Being satisfied with the reasons stated in the affidavit, and considering the submission made by the learned counsel for respondent Nos.7 to 9, and also considering the duration of delay, this Court is inclined to allow these petitions, but on terms. Accordingly, these Civil Miscellaneous Petitions are allowed on payment



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of cost of Rs.3,000/- (Rupees Three Thousand only) by the petitioner directly to
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respondent Nos.7 to 9 on or before 09.06.2025.
