3. The learned Special Government Pleader appearing for the first respondent submitted that the Joint Commissioner, HR and CE Department, has passed an order dated 09.07.2025, whereby it has been decided to appoint an



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Executive Officer to manage the temple affairs until the dispute between the petitioner and the private respondents is resolved.

4. In view of the above, this Court is of the considered opinion that nothing survives for further adjudication in the present writ petition. Accordingly, this Writ Petition stands closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
