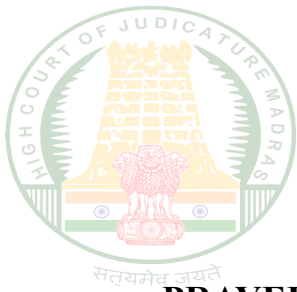

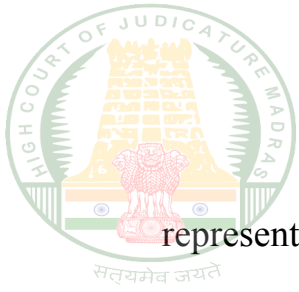
ORDER
