ORDER

Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate appearing for the official respondents and the learned counsel appearing for the private respondents.

2. The petitioner's allegation is that the private respondents are discharging the waste generated from their business premises into a nearby water body.

3. When the matter was taken up for hearing today, it is submitted that the respondents 6, 7 and 8 are not presently functioning. The ninth respondent is now functioning under a different name that is Lifaa See Foods. The learned Government

Taluk asserts that the ninth respondent has also made an independent arrangement. The waste generated from their business premises is not being let out into the nearby water body. This submission made by the ninth respondent is placed on record. If this statement turns out to be incorrect or false, it is always open to the petitioner to file contempt petition before us.

4. With the aforesaid direction, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
