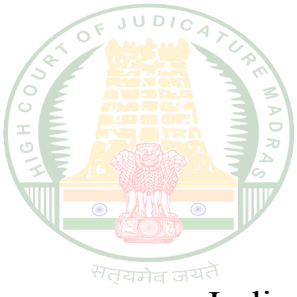

ORDER

The petitioner has approached this court with a grievance that the respondent police have not taken action on his complaint.

2.When this petition is taken up for hearing, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police submits that the complaint of the petitioner has been registered in CSR



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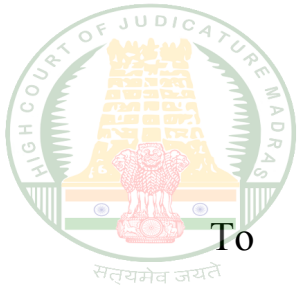
No.279/2025, dated 09.05.2025. They have issued summon to the petitioner to produce the relevant documents. Since the petitioner has not co-operated for enquiry and issue is also civil in nature, they have closed the complaint.

3.The learned Counsel for the petitioner disputed that it is a case of theft, but they are projecting it as a civil dispute.

4.Since the respondent police closed the complaint in CSR No. 279 of 2025, this petition is closed with a direction to the respondent police to furnish a copy of the closure report to the petitioner enabling him to workout his remedy in the manner known to law.
