This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr. K. Saravanan and the counsel for the respondent/s M/s. Charumathi are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

### **AWARD**

The husband, aggrieved by the order of the Family Court, Theni District, in M.C.No.122 of 2022 dated 23.05.2024 has preferred this Criminal Revision.

2. Today (ie., 08.03.2025), the petitioner/husband as well as the respondent/wife are present. Both parties have resolved their disputes and they report that they have re-joined and are living together happily.

3. In view of the above circumstances, the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the criminal revision.

4. We have affirmed the said position with the respondent/wife and she confirms the same. In view of the above, the order made in M.C.No.122 of 2022 on the file of the Family Court, Theni is hereby set aside by the consent of both the parties.

5. This Criminal Revision Case is disposed of, with the above terms.
