PRAYER: Criminal Revision Petition is filed under Section 438 r/w 442 of BNSS, 2023, to call for the records pertaining to the order dated 02.04.2025 passed in CRRP.No.16 of 2021 on the file of the learned Principal District and Sessions Court, Srivilliputhur, in CRMP.No.1307 of 2020 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Rajapalayam, order dated 12.03.2020, against M.C.No.21 of 2018 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Rajapalayam, and set aside the same.

ORDER

This Criminal Revision Petition is filed to call for the records pertaining to the order dated 02.04.2025 passed in CRRP.No.16 of 2021 on the file of the learned Principal District and Sessions Court, Srivilliputhur, in CRMP.No.1307 of 2020 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Rajapalayam, order dated 12.03.2020, against M.C.No.21 of 2018 on the file



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of the learned Judicial Magistrate, Rajapalayam, and set aside the same.

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2. The matter was referred to Mediation and the Mediation report in Mediation file No.592 of 2025 in this Criminal Revision case, has been received. The parties have entered into a settlement agreement on 13.08.2025 and have returned the respective movable and immovable properties and a one time settlement of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs only) has also been paid, by way of demand draft dated 11.08.2025 bearing No. 022078 drawn at State Bank of India, Srivilliputhur, to the petitioner wife and the same was duly acknowledged by her. The scanned copy of the Mediation Report is extracted as follows:

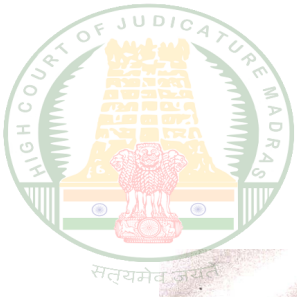

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Whereas

1. Disputes and differences had arisen between the parties hereto and Crl.R.C. (MD) No. 791 of 2025 filed on 30.06.2025 before the Hon'ble Madurai Bench of Madras High Court.

2. The matter was referred to Mediation/Conciliation vide an order dated 06.08.2025 passed by Hon'ble Mrs. Justice. L. Victoria Gowri.

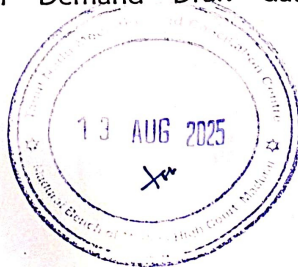
3. The parties agreed that Mr. V. Kannan and Mrs. P. Thangam would act as their Mediator/Conciliator.

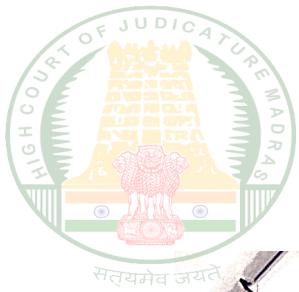
4. Meeting was held during the process of Mediation/Conciliation on 13.08.2025 (today) and the parties have with the assistance of Mediator/Conciliator Voluntarily arrived at an amicable solution resolving the above mentioned dispute & differences.

5. The parties hereto confirm and declare that they have voluntarily and of their own free will arrived at this settlement agreement in the presence of the Mediator/Conciliator.

6. The Following settlement has been arrived at between the parties hereto :

i) It is agreed by the Respondent that he has to pay a sum of Rs. 3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs only) to the Petitioner as full and final settlement of all claims and the Petitioner herein agreed that she will not make any monetary claim towards arrears of maintenance, compensation or damages etc. The Respondent/ husband has paid the said sum of Rs. 3,00,000/- by way of Demand Draft dated 11/08/2025 bearing





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No."022078" drawn at State Bank of India, Srivilliputhur to the Petitioner/ Wife and the same was also acknowledged by her.

ii) The Respondent/ Husband agreed to return the Gold Jewels and house hold articles belonging to the Petitioner. Accordingly, the Petitioner/ wife has received the above said Gold and house hold articles from the Respondent / husband on 13.08.2025 and the Respondent/ Wife hereby acknowledges the same.

iii) The Petitioner/ wife agreed to withdraw the maintenance case filed against the Respondent husband which is pending in M.C.No. 21 of 2018 on the file of the Learned Judicial Magistrate, Rajapalayam in the next hearing.

iv) The Petitioner/ wife has also no objection to quash the C.C.No. 208 of 2020 (Crime NO. 11 of 2017, AWPS, Rajapalayam) pending on the file of the Additional Mahila Court, Sirvilliputhur.

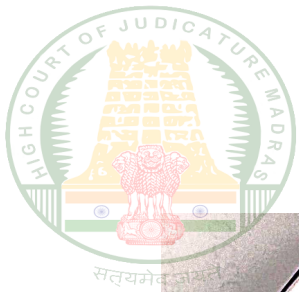
v) The Petitioner/ wife shall say no objection in CrI.O.P (MD) No. 20684 of 2023, which is filed to quash the above C.C.No. 208 of 2020 as against A1 and A2 pending on the file of this Hon'ble Court.

vi) The Petitioner / wife shall say no objection in CrI.O.P (MD) No. 17700 of 2023, which is filed to quash the C.C.No. 208 / 2020 against A3 pending on the file of this Hon'ble Court.

vii) The Petitioner / wife agreed to return the Thirumangalyam to the Respondent / Husband. Accordingly, the Petitioner/ wife has returned the Thirumangalyam on 13.08.2025 and the same is also acknowledged by the Respondent/ husband.

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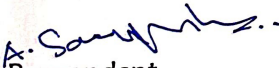

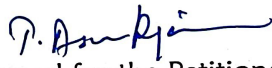
7. B.Abinayalakshmi appeared through video conferencing in Mediation and accepted the Settlement.

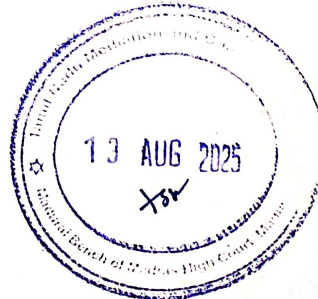

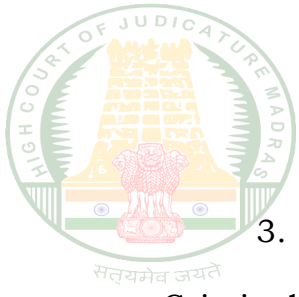
