PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.350 of 2025 on the file of the Respondent Police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/ A1, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under sections 191(2), 191(3), 140(1), 49, 115(2), 118(1), 351(3) and 333 of BNS, in Crime No.350 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and the defacto complainant were running mens hostel and due to business enmity, on 07.06.2025 at about 03.40 pm, at the instigation of the petitioner, the other accused persons were illegally kidnapped the defacto complainant in a Swift Desire Car bearing Reg.No.TN-59-BR-7102 and threatened him to close the hostel run by him, attacked him and also caused injuries. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent person and she has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Criminal Side) for the respondent police submitted that the injured was treated as out-patient. He further submitted that the investigation is almost completed.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also the facts that the injured was treated as out-patient, that the petitioner is not having any previous case



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for similar or serious offence and the investigation is almost completed, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, subject to certain conditions.

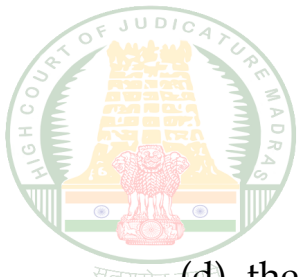
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6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of her arrest or on her appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Madurai on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Madurai, and on further conditions that:

(a) the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b) the petitioner shall furnish her residential address and mobile number to the learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Madurai. In the event of any change in her residential address, the petitioner shall report the same to the learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Madurai;

(c) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., until further orders;



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सत्यमेव जयते (d) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during
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(e) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(f) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court herself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;

(g) if the accused thereafter abscond, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS, 2023.
