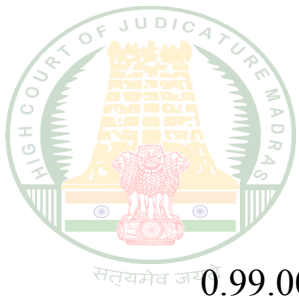

The petitioner herein seeks a direction to the respondents to consider his application, dated 14.03.2022, seeking grant of computerised patta in respect of the property situated in S.F.No.106/2 an extent of 0.99.00 cents in Alanthur Village, Kulithalai Taluk, Karur District.

2.Heard the arguments of Mr.S.Jayavel, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr.A.Baskaran, learned Additional Government Pleader, who takes notice for the respondents.

3. By consent of both sides, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.



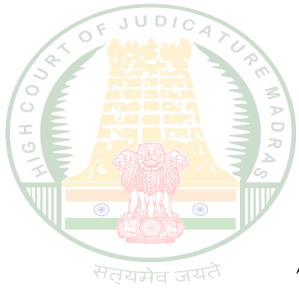

4. It is the case of the petitioner that the subject property was assigned in favour of petitioner on 26.04.1984 by the Government of Tamil Nadu. However, the revenue records have not been mutated in his favour. Therefore, the petitioner submitted a representation on 14.13.2022, seeking issuance of computerized patta. The same has not been considered. Hence, the petitioner has come before this Court.

5. It is seen from the typed set of papers, based on the representation submitted by the petitioner, the third respondent already called for report from the fourth respondent in his proceedings in O.Mu.No.A1/2180/2022, dated 14.03.2022. Thereafter, there is no progress in the matter. Hence, the petitioner has come before this Court.

6. The The Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents would submit that the representation of the petitioner will be considered in accordance with law.
