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Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Standing Counsel for the respondent.

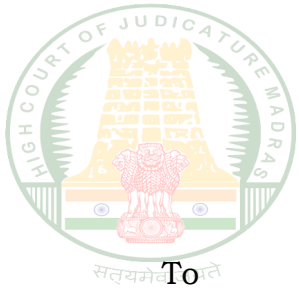
