PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :- For Bail in Crime No.139 of 2025 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER: This Court made the following order :-

The petitioner / Accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody



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on 04.06.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 194 of BNSS @ 108 of BNS

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in Crime No.139 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the defacto-complainant's husband is working as Pump Operator at Avudaiapuram Village Panchayat, Virudhungan Taluk. The petitioner is the Panchayat Secretary in the said Village Panchayat. In the work place, this petitioner frequently abused the defacto-complainant's husband. Due to which, on 30.05.2025, he committed suicide by hanging. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that in this case, the petitioner is an innocent person and he has not committed any offences as alleged by the prosecution. The petitioner is ready and willing to abide any conditions that may be imposed by this Court. He would further submit that the petitioner is in custody from 04.06.2025 nearly 35 days. Hence, he seeks bail.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) would submit that this petitioner working as a Panchayat Secretary in the Avudaiapuram Village Panchayat. The deceased working as a Pump Operator in the same village



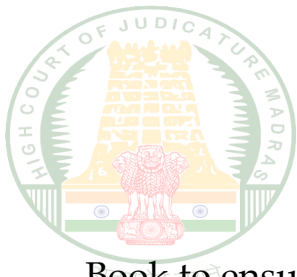
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Panchayat. This petitioner abused the deceased in the work place frequently, due to mental agony, the deceased committed suicide by hanging. In this case, suicide note recovered by the respondent police. There is no previous case against this petitioner. However, he objected to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also taking note of the fact that in this case, FIR registered on 30.05.2025, by this time most of the investigation might have been completed, there is no previous case against this petitioner, the petitioner/accused is in judicial custody from 04.06.2025, taking into consideration of the period of incarceration, this court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Virudhunagar and on further conditions that :-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass



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Book to ensure their identity.

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[b] The petitioner shall furnish his residential address and contact number to the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Virudhunagar. If the petitioner changes his residential address, he shall report the same to the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Virudhunagar;

[c] the petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent police, daily at 10.30.a.m., until further orders.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court



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in P.K.Shaji .vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

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[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under
Section 269 BNS.
