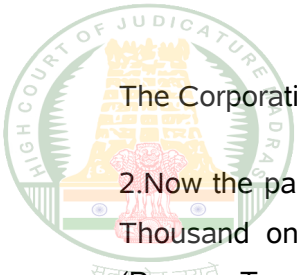

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr.P.Prabhakaran and the counsel for respondents 1 to 9 Mr.K.Kannan Gurusami are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD



The Corporation has filed the above appeal challenging the award passed by the Tribunal.

2. Now the parties have arrived at a settlement for a sum of Rs.4,95,000/- (Rupees Four Lakh Ninety Five Thousand only) in full quit. The appellant Corporation has already deposited a sum of Rs.2,25,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Twenty Five Thousand only). The Transport Corporation is directed to pay the balance amount within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this award. On such deposit, the claimants are permitted to withdraw the amount as apportioned by the Tribunal.

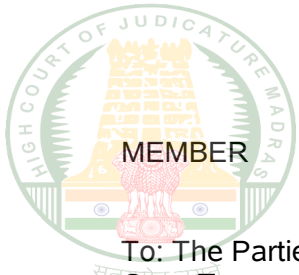
