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ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the respondents to disburse interest at the rate of 6% p.a. for the belated payment of retirement benefits, namely, Gratuity, Provident Fund, Leave Salary and Commutation.

2. The petitioner's husband was appointed as a 'Driver' in the respondent Corporation on 01.04.2010. After completing 12 years of service, he passed away on 15.07.2022. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the terminal benefits of the petitioner's husband have not been settled promptly and that there has been an abnormal delay in disbursing the same.

3. In view of the same, the only issue to be considered in this Writ Petition is with regard to interest payable on the belated settlement. This issue was dealt with by this Court on various occasions and this Court passed orders in several Writ Petitions. In fact, the issue involved in this writ petition is no longer *res-integra*.

4. This Court in **W.P(MD)No.4866 of 2023 (C.Murugan vs. The Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation (Tirunelveli) Ltd., and another)** by order dated **07.03.2023** has decided this issue.



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5. Accordingly, by following the order stated supra, this Writ Petition is allowed with the following direction:-

The respondents shall pay interest to the petitioner at the rate of 6% per annum on the belated payment of the terminal benefits commencing from the date of death of the petitioner's husband, till the date of actual disbursement, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

There shall be no order as to costs.
