This Criminal Original Petition is filed seeking to quash the FIR in Crime No.20 of 2025 on the file of the first respondent Police, which was registered for the offences under Sections 296(b) and 118(1) of BNS.

2. The allegation in the FIR is that on account of prior enmity, the petitioners attacked the defacto complainant, caused him simple injuries and abused him in filthy language and thus, committed the aforesaid offences.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the defacto complainant/the second respondent would submit that the parties have now entered into a compromise on the advise of the elders and well-wishers and both the parties have agreed that the impugned F.I.R may be quashed.

4.The parties have also filed a joint compromise memo dated 06.10.2025. The scanned copy of the compromise memo reads as follows:

The Petitioners/Accused No. 1 and 3 and the 2nd Respondent would jointly submit that the petitioners and 2nd respondent would be compromised the above said incident dated 17.02.2025 in connection with Crime No. 19 of 2025. Hence the 2nd respondent would like that not to action as against the above petitioners and would like that no proceedings as legally as against the petitioners. It is just and necessary welfare of the petitioners and 2nd respondent shall not be come to the criminality based on the said case. Now both are as very well like that they said compromise in Crime No. 20 of 2025 due to that effect this compromise between the petitioner and the 2nd respondent filed this petition before this Hon'ble Court. Further nothing happened as alleged by the prosecution in so far as the petitioner is concerned. After registering the FIR they have shed all their misunderstanding and have compromised in the presence of the well-wishers and have mutually agreed to withdraw in the above case in Crime No. 20 of 2025 on the file of the Manikandam Police Station, Trichy District in so far as the petitioners are concerned.

5. The Petitioners/Accused No. 1 and 3 and the 2nd Respondent would jointly submit that herein the A2 is brother of the 1st petitioner. The petitioner submits that the Petitioners/ Accused No. 1 and 3 and 2nd Respondent would jointly submit that the matter has been compromised between both of them with intervention of the mediator and well-wishers of both sides without any inducement made by others. The Defacto Complainant has specifically admitted that he has no objection if the FIR in question is quashed in so far as the petitioner is concerned alone. Further they have given an undertaking that Defacto Complainant is ready to withdraw the complaint and no objection to quash the FIR in Crime No. 20 of 2025 on the file of the Manikandam Police Station, Trichy District.

7. The Petitioners/Accused No. 1 and 3 and the 2nd Respondent would jointly submit that such compromise has been taken place purely with an intention to settle their dispute among them and it is purely voluntary by the parties concerned. Hence, in order to avoid further ordeal of trial before the Trial Court, they are preferred to be present before this Hon'ble Court whenever it is required. This Hon'ble Court by taking into consideration of the above said aspects with regard to the compromise and in the interest of the parties, can leniently look into the present issue, as such the prayer sought for by the Petitioner can be allowed.

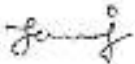
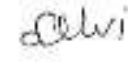

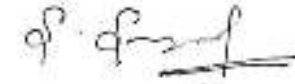
