PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :- For Bail in Crime No.127 of 2025 on the file of the respondent Police.



ORDER: The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioner / Accused, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 16.05.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 296(b), 118(1), 351(3) of BNS altered into 296(b), 103(1) and 351(3) of BNS, in Crime No.127 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail,

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and his brother were taken housing loan from Five Star Finance, Thiruchuli and were paying EMI regularly. Further, the petitioner's brother worked at Coimbatore who is the son-in-law of the defacto complainant, he was not able to pay the EMI for some months. Further, the Finance company asked the petitioner to pay the EMI, hence, the petitioner has asked the Finance Company to ask the defacto complainant. Due to which, there was a wordy quarrel between the petitioner and the defacto complainant, as a result of which, on 15.05.2025 at about 2.00 p.m., the petitioner abused the defacto complainant in filthy language and attacked the husband of the defacto complainant with wooden long and caused injury, thereafter, he was admitted in the hospital, he died. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is an



innocent person and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. He would further submit that there is no previous case pending against the petitioner. He would further submit that the petitioner is in judicial custody from 16.05.2025. Hence, he seeks bail.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) would submit that the investigation is almost completed and there is no previous case pending against the petitioner. However, he objected to grant bail to the petitioner.

5. Taking into consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact that there is no previous case pending against the petitioner and the investigation has been almost completed and taking into consideration of the period of incarceration suffered by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to the following conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate, Tiruchuli, and on further conditions that :-



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[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] The petitioner shall furnish his residential address and mobile number to the Judicial Magistrate, Tiruchuli .

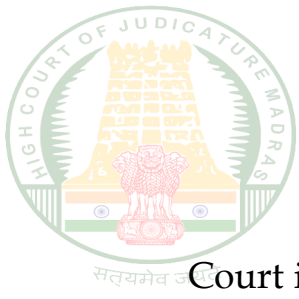
(c)If the petitioner changes his residential address, he shall report the same to the Judicial Magistrate, Tiruchuli .

[d] the petitioner shall stay at Madurai, and report before the Inspector of Police, Annanagar Police, Station, Madurai at 10.00 a.m., and 05.00 p.m., until further orders..

[e] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[f] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[g] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme



Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

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[h] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
