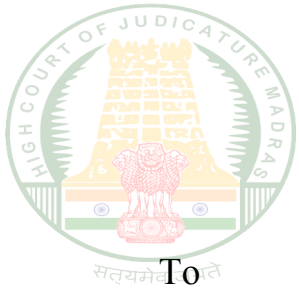
COMMON ORDER
