ORDER

Thus, the authorities have proposed to remove the encroachments in Sl.Nos.581, 582, 583 and 596. Since the doubt raised by the petitioner is clarified, no further adjudication is to be undertaken.

4. Accordingly, the writ petition stands dismissed. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
