PRAYER :- To extend the time to comply the order made in CrI.O.P.(MD).No.8425 of 2025 dated 08.05.2025

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

This petition has been filed for extension of time for compliance of the conditional order passed in CrI.O.P(MD).No.8425 of 2025 dated 08.05.2025.

2. The learned Counsel for the petitioners would submit that this Hon'ble Court passed an order in CrI.O.P(MD).No.8425 of 2025 dated 08.05.2025 and enlarged the petitioners herein on anticipatory bail. He further submits that there is a typographical error occurred in the sections in the said anticipatory bail petition. In order to rectify the same, the petitioner has filed an amendment petition before this Court in CrI.M.P.(MD).No.6656 of 2025 in CrI.OP(MD).No.8425 of 2025 and the same allowed by this Court on 04.06.2025. For the above said reason, the petitioners are unable to produce surety and surrender before the concerned Court within the time stipulated by this Court. For the said reason only, they are unable to comply the conditions imposed by this Court in CrI.O.P.(MD).No.8425 of 2025 dated 08.05.2025. Hence, he prayed to extend the time period, by allowing this

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3. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) appearing for the respondent has not raised any objection to allow this Criminal Miscellaneous Petition.
