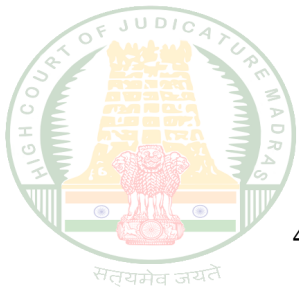

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2.The case of the prosecution is that on 03.07.2025 at about 10.15 pm, near Eriodu Government Middle School, the petitioners along with other accused abused the defacto complainant, by stating his caste name and also attacked the defacto complainant with knife. Hence, the case.

3.The learned Government Advocate(crl.side) appearing for the respondent police submits that this occurrence is of retaliation to the earlier incident, which was registered in Crime No.150 of 2025 He further submits that this Court has already considered the application filed by the Accused Nos.1 and 2 in Crl.O.P(MD) No.12301 of 2025 and the said application was dismissed on 22.07.2025.
