PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.Not Known of 2025 on the file of the Respondent Police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 120(b), 406, 417, 420, 468, 471 of IPC in Crime No. Not Known of 2025, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side), on instructions, submits that current paper is pending for enquiry.

3. The learned Counsel for the petitioner submitted that the respondent police is harassing the petitioner under the guise of enquiry.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner is directed to appear before respondent police for enquiry and cooperate for the enquiry. The respondent police is directed to follow the procedure under Section 35 of BNSS, and to conduct the enquiry and if any prima facie case is made out against the petitioner, register the F.I.R. or close the petition enquiry within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



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5. Till such time, the petitioner shall not be arrested by the respondent police.
6. With the above directions, this criminal original petition is disposed of.
