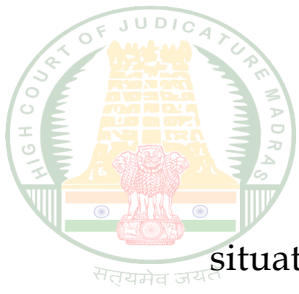

**PRAYER:** Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents 1 to 3 to cancel the assignment patta issued in favour of fourth respondent in respect of Natham land



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situated in S.NO.403/21, Pappanam Village, Nagaratharkurichi Group Village, Abiramam, Kamuthi Taluk, Ramanathapuram District.

### **ORDER**

The Petitioner herein seeks a direction to the respondents 1 to 3 to cancel the assignment patta issued in favour of fourth respondent in respect of Natham land situated in S.NO.403/21, Pappanam Village, Nagaratharkurichi Group Village, Abiramam, Kamuthi Taluk, Ramanathapuram District.

2.Mrs.S.Jeya Priya, learned Government Advocate takes notice for the respondents 1 to 3. By consent of both parties,the Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself. Since no adverse order is passed against the fourth respondent, notice to him is dispensed with.

3.According to the Petitioner, the subject property is a public street and without taking into consideration the said fact, assignment patta has been issued in favour of fourth respondent.



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Hence the Petitioner submitted a representation on 3.4.2025 before the second respondent seeking cancellation of assignment patta issued in favour of fourth respondent. The same has not been considered so far. Hence the Petitioner has come before this Court with the present Writ Petition for the relief stated supra.

4.Mrs.S.Jeya Priya, learned Government Advocate, who takes notice for the respondents 1 to 3 would submit that pursuant to the representation submitted by the Petitioner, date of enquiry is fixed at 01.08.2025 as per the order passed by the second respondent in Ba.Mu(A4)/1065/2023, dated 14.11.2023.

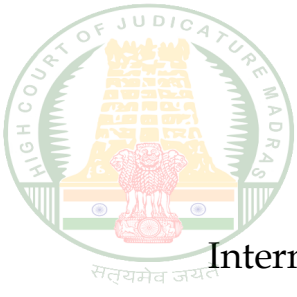
5.In view of the same, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter, the second respondent is directed to consider the representation of the Petitioner, dated 03.04.2025 and pass final orders on its own merits after affording reasonable opportunity to the Petitioner and fourth respondent within a period of 12 weeks from the date of a copy of this order.

6.With the above directions, the Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.
